The Advanced Conservation workshop is intended for individuals who have completed the Basic Workshop and wish to learn more complicated procedures for the conservation of gravestones and monuments. The Advanced Workshop is not intended for either professionals or those already utilizing advanced techniques while working in gravestone and monument conservation. All attendees will gain knowledge and experience in the following:

- Detailed assessment and documentation, including use of GPS, of gravestones and monuments.
- Cleaning techniques and stone consolidation.
- Drilling and blind pinning of stone fragments.
- The use of various mortars for infills and replacement of lost material.

Demonstration and practical application of leveling and lifting larger monuments will also be covered. Equipment to be used will be an assortment of jacks, tripod, and a small tractor/excavator lift using straps. The equipment being demonstrated assumes the space where the damaged monument stands would be too difficult to reach using standard hydraulic lifting equipment from a truck.

Please wear clothing well suited for outdoor work like gardening, including boots or work shoes and leather work gloves. Please also remember to bring sunscreen and/or insect repellent if you desire.
