

## **AGS Basic Foil Impressions Workshop 2010 Friday June 25, 2010**

In this workshop participants will learn the process of making gravestone rubbings with lightweight foil. Foil impressions require more time to create than traditional rubbings on paper, but can capture depth of carving and other design detail. Also, there is no risk of inadvertently damaging stones because the impressions are created without using paint, crayon, or wax in the cemetery.

Participants will be able to learn the process in a classroom setting by practicing on gravestone casts. Topics covered will be selection of a suitable stone for rubbing, types of foil, the right tools, rubbing technique, finishing, and framing. Each participant will be able to complete a rubbing during the class that can be taken home, finished, and framed.
