Late Night presentations are fun and informal. It's an entertaining way to unwind after a day of workshops, tours, and lectures. Presenters often show slideshows of interesting gravestones they have seen in their travels, or share information about projects they are working on. The presentations are limited to 10 minutes in length to allow everyone a chance to participate. If one wishes to present a longer, scholarly presentation, late night is not the proper forum. Instead, the presenter should submit a paper for consideration for the evening lecture or participation sessions.

Anyone wishing to present at late night should indicate this in Section A of the registration form. After your registration has been processed by the registrar, your information will be passed on to the late night coordinator. The late night coordinator will then contact you to collect additional information about your presentation. You will be notified of your presentation date at least one week prior to the conference.

If you decide to present at late night and have not indicated this on your registration form, you may be accommodated, but only if time allows at the end of the evening.

Snacks and soft drinks will be provided for late night. Alcoholic beverages are permitted, and are BYOB. A donation box will be passed around to help cover the snack costs.
